Magic sounds box - Christmas

You will need: a small box with a (flap) lid – eg washing powder tablet or teabag box; Christmas-y objects, such as Santa, robin, bells, cracker, scrunched wrapping paper.

Playing with a magic sounds box helps young children to:

- listen carefully
- 🗱 enjoy waiting for something to happen
- 🔆 experience different sounds and rhythms
- 🔆 enjoy making different sounds with you.

What to do:

- Sit down opposite your child, holding the box.
- 2. The box becomes 'magic' when you turn it around in your hand, saying the rhyme:
 - 'Turn turn turn the box round Lift the lid and *listen* for the sound!' Point to your ear as you say 'listen'.
- 3. As you open the lid (without letting your child/ren see inside) make a sound that matches one of the objects and keep going until you shut the lid.



- 4. Show them the object after they've guessed.
- 5. Encourage your child to get involved and make the sounds with you.
