

Sensory play - Ice pictures or mobiles

Put some leaves, berries, pebbles, etc in a small plastic bowl or tub. Partly cover them in water - shallow will freeze more quickly. Put the ends (or middle) of a piece of string in the water if you want to hang it up.

Put the tub outside if it's really cold (or freezer) for a few hours until the water's frozen, then remove the tub.

There's lots to talk and wonder about together: Do any of the items float? Why did the water turn solid? What happens when it warms up? Curiosity and 'investigating' are the start of early science thinking - you don't need to know

the 'answers', just have fun trying things out together!


